ORDINANCE NO. 750

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TROY, KANSAS EXPANDING THE DAYS AND HOURS WHEN CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE IN THE ORIGINAL PACKAGE AND ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR IN THE ORIGINAL PACKAGE MAY BE SOLD IN THE CITY OF TROY, KANSAS; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE PUBLISHED FOR TWO (2) CONSECUTIVE WEEKS; AND GIVING NOTICE THAT IF, WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS FOLLOWING THE SECOND PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, A PETITION REQUESTING THAT THE PROPOSITION HEREIN SET FORTH BE SUBMITTED FOR APPROVAL BY THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TROY, KANSAS IS FILED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS AND PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 41-2911 SUCH ORDINANCE SHALL NOT BECOME EFFECTIVE UNTIL THE PROPOSITION HEREIN PROVIDED FOR IS SUBMITTED TO AND APPROVED BY SAID VOTERS.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 79-2911 now provides that the Governing Body of a Kansas city may expand the days and hours when cereal malt beverage in the original package and alcoholic liquor in the original package may be sold in said city; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Troy, Kansas has determined that expanding the days and hours when cereal malt beverage in the original package and alcoholic liquor in the original package may be sold in the City of Troy is economically beneficial to the City and permits licensed businesses in the City to compete with businesses in nearby cities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TROY, KANSAS:


SECTION 1. Except as provided in Section 2 of this Ordinance all stores in the City of Troy, Kansas licensed to sell cereal malt beverage in the original package and alcoholic liquor in the original package may be open and sell said products as follows: (A) Monday through Saturday between the hours of 9 AM and 11 PM; (B) on Sunday between the hours of 12 PM and 8 PM.

SECTION 2. All stores in the City of Troy, Kansas licensed to sell cereal malt beverage in the original package and alcoholic liquor in the original package must be closed on Easter, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper. Said Ordinance shall not become effective earlier than sixty (60) days following the date of its second publication. If, within sixty (60) days following the second publication of this Ordinance, a petition requesting that the proposition herein presented relative to


when stores in the City of Troy, Kansas licensed to sell cereal malt beverage in the original package and alcoholic liquor in the original package may be open and sell said products be submitted for approval by the voters of the City of Troy, Kansas is filed in accordance with the terms and provisions of K.S.A. 41-2911, this ordinance shall not become effective until the proposition is submitted to and approved by said voters at an election as provided for by K.S.A. 41-2911. If no petition relative to the proposition herein presented is filed pursuant to the terms and provisions of K.S.A. 41-2911 then this Ordinance shall become effective sixty-one (61) days following the second publication thereof.
